Implementation of the Waste Avoidance and Resource Recovery Strategy 2030



BACKGROUND

In February 2019, the State Government released the Waste Avoidance and Resource Recovery Strategy 2030. The new Waste Strategy aims to make Western Australia a sustainable, low-waste, circular economy in which human health and the environment are protected from the impacts of waste.

The [Waste Strategy](#) is accompanied by an [Action Plan](#). It provides a strategic framework for managing waste and guides the Waste Authority in delivering its programs and the development of advice to government.

Key points include:

- Moving all Perth and Peel households to three-bin Food Organics and Garden Organics by 2025
- Target to reduce waste generation by 20 per cent and increase recovery to 75 per cent by 2030
- A commitment to use recycled construction and demolition waste as road base under the Roads to Reuse program
- A strategic review of WA's waste and recycling infrastructure by 2020 to guide future development.

WALGA, in partnership with the Cities of Melville and Stirling, are hosting a series of Information Sessions where Local Government Officers and Elected Members can learn more about the Strategy. Speakers include representatives from the Waste Authority and the Department of Water and Environmental Regulation.
